## Roles and responsibilities of Officers

- Chairperson
- Resides at all meetings
- Responsible for convening meetings \& general oversight of Board activities
- President
- General manager of the Corporation
- Supervise, direct, \& manage the Corporation's activities, affairs, \& Officers
- Preside in the absence of the Chairperson at all meetings


## Roles and responsibilities of Officers

- Treasurer
- Submit annual budget for approval by the Board
- Prepare monthly financial reports to the Board
- Receive \& make deposits
- Direct reimbursements
- Secretary
- Ensure proper notices is given for meetings
- Prepare agenda
- Record \& distribute minutes from Board meetings
