- Issue: The current bylaws and standing rules allow Non-Members to be Board Directors and Officers. There are some concerns about this.
- Solution:
 - Directors
 - Evaluate advantages/disadvantages of allowing Non-Members to be Board Directors
 - Officers
 - Identify the roles and responsibilities of each Officer position (Chairperson, President, Treasurer, Secretary)
 - Evaluate advantages/disadvantages of allowing Non-Members for each Officer position

Roles and responsibilities of Officers

- Chairperson
 - Resides at all meetings
 - Responsible for convening meetings & general oversight of Board activities
- President
 - General manager of the Corporation
 - Supervise, direct, & manage the Corporation's activities, affairs, & Officers
 - Preside in the absence of the Chairperson at all meetings

Roles and responsibilities of Officers

- Treasurer
 - Submit annual budget for approval by the Board
 - Prepare monthly financial reports to the Board
 - Receive & make deposits
 - Direct reimbursements

- Secretary
 - Ensure proper notices is given for meetings
 - Prepare agenda
 - Record & distribute minutes from Board meetings
