## Membership Survey Results

Jan. 2023

## Purpose

- Gauge the number of dues-paying members that are active in the community as opposed to those that are inactive
- Better understand how often and for what activities each of the two locations are used, down to rooms and larger machines
- Better understand the wants and needs of active members in regards to location amenities, classes, tools, and other offerings
- Better understand our current volunteering activity and roadblocks to increasing that activity among our members


## Section 1: Methodology and Initial Results

## Methodology

- Survey conducted via Google forms
- Link sent out via mass email to list found on website
- Link was posted in multiple Slack channels
- Reminders were given at member meetings by the president
- Survey questions consisted of:
- multiple choice
- check boxes
- ranking
- short answer
- long answer
- Some questions were mandatory, some were not

Location-specific, niche-activities (ie teaching a class), and suggestion questions were optional

- Survey covered five main topics, in order:
general questions (background information about the respondee)
- non-location-specific activities questions
- Purcellville-specific questions
- Leesburg-specific questions
- volunteering questions.
- Survey was open for three months
- opened on October 31st, 2022
- closed on January 31st, 2023


## Initial results

- 78 responses
- 42.5 respondents on average for non-location specific activities questions
- 68.25 respondents on average for Leesburg optional questions
- 58.875 respondents on average for Purcellville optional questions
- 44 average respondents to optional suggestion-based questions
- What would you add to rooms in Purcellville?
- What would you add to rooms in Leesburg?
- What classes are not currently offered, but you would take if they were?
- Some responses to these were "none"

Other Trends and Takeaways

## Other trends I noticed:

- There seems to be two groups of active member
- A larger group that spend some time at the space
- A smaller group that spends A LOT of time at the space

- A lot of issues around volunteering COULD be communication issues
- Blockers were reported as time constraints and scheduling issues
- Perhaps we need to better communicate non-work-day/"regular" volunteer opportunities
- Stewards would get a lot of insight out of the raw data
- Overall, respondents seem fairly satisfied with Makersmiths as a whole, but see room for improvement in specific rooms/shops
- Our tool offerings are our lynchpin so far
- Either a). It's the most important thing to members and potential members
- Or b). We're only retaining the people that feel it is most important
- People want to teach, but often feel too inadequate
- 78 respondents is close to the 79 votes we had during the last election, and we hit. That's two data points that point towards that number being our actually-active active-members.
